

# Photo Balloon Inflation Instructions

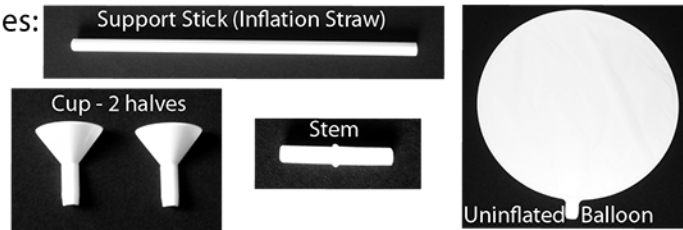
## 22" Helium Ready Balloon

You can take the helium ready balloon to any helium supplier (local grocery store, party store, florist, etc.) and have it inflated with helium and attach a ribbon/string. There is a self sealing valve. When the helium no longer floats, you can deflate the balloon by following the Deflation Instructions below. You can store the deflated balloon as a keepsake, or re-inflate it at any time.

## 11" TableTop Balloon (will not float with helium - inflate with air only)

TableTop Balloon Includes:



1) To inflate balloon, carefully insert white stem through the white tab at the bottom of the balloon leaving 1/16" of an inch outside of the flap.

2) Align the two piece Cup on each side of the Stem, making sure the lip around the center of the Stem aligns with the grooves inside the Cups.

The Cups should close & meet forming a uniform circular Cup.



3) Insert the Support Stand Straw over the end of the Cups and push up while turning until the Cups are firmly held together.



4) Carefully blow through the Straw until the balloon is completely filled. The valve inside the balloon will automatically close. There is no need to close the opening at the end of the Support Stand Straw.

## Deflation Instructions

To deflate the balloon, lay on a clean, flat surface and remove all the parts you used to inflate the balloon. Using a thin straw or coffee stirrer, gently insert into the white tab in the bottom of the balloon about 1 1/2 inches until the air starts to release. Gently press down on the balloon with the palm of your hand until the balloon completely deflates.

You can re-inflated the balloon at any time by following the procedures above.
